



WHAT WE LEARNED

- Immigrant communities are severely disengaged due to lack of services and animosity
- Culture clashes have caused extreme points of friction
- The Israeli minority has lost ownership over its home
- There is a lack of public space; existing space is sparse and in poor condition
- The cultural diversity of the neighborhood has never been leveraged to shift and improve perceptions
